






- Scoping Period January 6 to February 7, 2022
- Notice: 3 pages
- Notifies responsible agencies and public that a Draft EIR will be prepared
- 30-day public scoping period
- Public Scoping Meeting Jan 19 (virtual)

(1970) is a statute that generally reavies state and local agencies to identify ne significant environmental impacts of their proposed actions and to avoid, reduce or mitigate those impacts, if feasible, if the project is not exempt from review.

To comply with CEQA, potential significant environmental impacts of proposed development projects are often identified analyzed and shared with the public and other agencies through the environmental review process in the form of an Environmental Impact Report (EIR).
